For Children...

A once in a lifetime opportunity for children to perform on stage in front of friends, family and public audiences, alongside other schools in the project. Children's learning is transformed and their awareness of theatre making and social skills are vastly improved.

Fun workshops in their schools introduce children to creative play and drama techniques in advance of visiting the theatre, often for the first time. By performing high quality, age-appropriate scripts that children can easily relate to and enjoy, they develop their acting and oracy skills, gain confidence and a growth mindset of positivity and achievement.

PROJECT TIMELINE

September 2023 - February 2024:

Schools sign up for the project (Deadline for signing up: 09 February 2024)

Saturday 02 March 2024: Digital Writers Workshop

- The Playhouse partners, playwrights and teachers from across the UK come together for a Digital Writers Workshop, held over Zoom.
- This digital workshop will help teachers from primary schools across the UK to discover more about the play they have chosen.
- Teachers will have the opportunity to talk to the writer of their chosen script and learn more about the play and the writer's vision, as well as explore new ways of developing their directing skills with children & young people.

Wednesday 22 April 2024: Teachers Workshop Day

- The teachers from the schools in Wales will come together for a Teacher's Workshop Day, where there will be specific Professional Development Opportunities to help their directing skills and how to get the best out of a large cast of young people.
- The Teacher Workshop Day is run by Theatr Iolo and will be in person at The Riverfront, Newport.
- The day will be split into 2 sessions, the morning session will be led by Theatr Iolo's creative practitioner with the afternoon session being run by The Riverfront's technical team to explore the technical considerations of your chosen play.

10 & 11 June 2024: Backstage Tour

• Teachers will be invited to the Riverfront on one of these days for a tour of the backstage. Dates and times will be arranged by The Riverfront.


May & June 2024:

- Teachers will rehearse their chosen play during this period in their school.
- A Theatr Iolo practitioner will visit the school for either one full day or two half-day sessions to provide bespoke advice and guidance on how to direct their performance. (exact dates to be agreed between the practitioner and the school)

8 & 9 July 2024 : Performance Day

- One of these 2 days will be your performance day, this is when your class will perform their play to family and friends [] at The Riverfront, Newport.
- Performance times will be arranged by Theatr Iolo and The Riverfront.

PLAYHOUSE COST?



A digital workshop for the lead teacher to come together with the venues, playwrights and participating schools from across the UK

The lead teacher will take part in a full day, in-person workshop with a practitioner and other teachers from Wales to explore the process of directing a play and provide ideas to take back to the classroom. Lunch and refreshments will be provided.

A full day or two half-day day visits at your school from a Theatr Iolo practitioner for one-to-one support to help you get the most from your class and your play choice.

A half day visit from a member of the Theatr Iolo team following the workshop in which you will be offered advice and guidance. Unlimited access to the Theatr Iolo team whilst rehearsing the production for help and advice

A backstage tour of The Riverfront for your whole class.
